GARBAGE and ONE BULK ITEM per Household will continue to be picked up Every Thursday

- *Place Garbage to the Curb by 6:30 AM (or the night before)
- *Garbage Cans **MUST** be standard 32 gallon containers weighing *less than 50 lbs.*

Mine Hill Township Vegetative Waste Schedule for 2012

**VEGETATIVE WASTE will continue to be picked up Every OTHER Tuesday
Beginning March 27 and Ending December 4**

- *Place Vegetative Waste to the Curb by 6:30 AM (or the night before)
- *Branches and Brush **MUST** be cut to 4' (four foot) lengths and bundled with twine
- *Grass Clippings and Leaves **MUST** either be bagged in Brown Yard Waste Bags or placed in a **CLEARLY MARKED** 32 gallon container weighing less than 50 lbs. Yard Waste Bags are available for purchase at Town Hall (10 bags for \$5).
